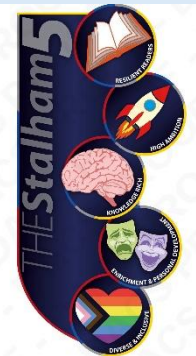

Themes/ Content/ Units covered 	 Unit: UK Politics  Unit: Exploring the development of British democracy and politics, developing their understanding of contemporary UK politics through a deeper exploration of the five main political parties, examining their histories, key beliefs, policies and roles within British democracy.	 Unit: Mental Health and Emotional Wellbeing  Focussing on new challenges, reframing negative thinking, recognising mental ill-health, change, loss grief and promoting emotional wellbeing.	Unit: RSE   Looking at the role of intimacy and pleasure. Pressure, persuasion, and coercion – consent. Managing relationship conflict and breakups and addressing relationship abuse.	Unit: Physical Wellbeing  Looking at drug education, body modification, periods and menstruation, the importance of sleep, lifestyle  s and wellbeing and managing the influences of lifestyle decisions.	 Unit: Capital Punishment and Crime  Looking at the purpose of punishment from a secular and religious POV, plus the arguments surrounding capital punishment.	Unit: Careers Spotlight This unit explores a range of career pathways and opportunities, helping students consider the options available to them beyond school. Students will explore different industries, roles and routes into employment, including university,  apprenticeships and vocational pathways.
