Special perk too! Student Librarians can be allowed into the library even when it has reached capacity — giving you a little extra library access as part of the role.

- ✓ **Encourages intercultural competence:** Enhances awareness, respect, and a deeper appreciation of diverse languages and backgrounds.
- ✓ **Makes new friends:** Offers a chance to connect with others, learn new things, and take pride in helping the school community.

## What is an Autism Ambassador?

- ✓ An Autism Ambassador is a student who helps others understand autism and supports autistic students in school.
- ✓ They help make sure everyone feels included, respected, and able to be themselves.



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## AS AN AUTISM AMBASSADOR, YOU WILL:



- ✓ Promote understanding and acceptance of autism.
- ✓ Support autistic students to feel welcome and included.
- ✓ Encourage kindness, respect, and friendship.
- ✓ Help raise awareness through school events and activities.
- ✓ Listen to others and help them find support when needed.
