

Annual Activity Survey for Stalham High School

Welcome to Children's Services' annual Activity Survey, 2022. It provides information about the first destinations of young people reaching the statutory school leaving age in the summer of 2022. With over 8000 young people to follow up each year it takes the dedication of a number of key people to make the survey possible. I would like to thank staff at schools, colleges and sixth forms along with Norfolk County Council's Guidance Advisers, Young Persons' Advisers, Keeping in Touch Team and staff from the Participation, Transition & Strategy Team. It is worth noting that all young people are expected to continue in education or training (in learning) until at least 18 years of age. Therefore the 'in-learning' figures are a particularly important focus of this report - which as you will see have slightly dipped compared to 2021. This is due in part to an increase of young people going into jobs without training and more young people not in education, employment or training (NEET) at this time. However, on a positive note the number of young people in an apprenticeship has increased, and our unknowns are lower than at this time last year.




The total number of Year 11 students in Norfolk's schools for the academic year


Full Time Education



The percentage of young people who are **NEET**


