Themes/Content/Units covered	Unit: What are the strengths and weaknesses of the legal system? Looking at how laws are made, who enforces them and the differences between criminal and civil law. Exploring how the youth justice system works, what sentencing is and how the law applies to young people specifically.	Unit: RSE Looking at the role of intimacy and pleasure. Pressure, persuasion, and coercion – consent. Managing relationship conflict and breakups and addressing relationship abuse.	Unit: Capital Punishment and Crime Looking at the purpose of punishment from a secular and religious POV, plus the arguments surrounding capital punishment.	Unit: Explicit Material Looking at the impact explicit material has on our attitudes and behaviour and the damage it can do to relationships. Understanding exploitation, the spiral of addiction and the law surrounding pornography.	Unit: How does the media hold those in power to account? Looking at the role of the media in our democracy, what responsible journalism is and how the media supports democracy. Exploring what false information is, what we can do about it, and whether the media should ever be censored.	Unit: Mental Health and Emotional Wellbeing Focussing on new challenges, reframing negative thinking, recognising mental ill-health, change, loss grief and promoting emotional wellbeing.
